TRAIL & COURSE

Half Marathon Course: Runners will be shuttled to the Dairy Queen in Eagle River for the start. After 3 miles, the race will utilize Section 9 and Sundstein Roads to get from the North section of the trail to the South trail. Due to this paved section of road (as well as the paved section near the finish), runners should not wear spikes. Runners will also cross boardwalks and a bridge. Elevation changes are minor.

5K Course: Runners will be shuttled to the Petroleum Museum on Wykoski Road, near the start line.

Finish: Within the final mile, participants will exit the trail on Anderson Street in downtown Three Lakes and continue on a series of paved roads before ending at the Reiter Center. There will be traffic monitors along the way. A detailed map of the finish can be found on our website.

Aid Stations: Water & Gatorade will be available in cups, along with first aid. The seven aid stations are evenly spaced and shown on the map to the left, which is also available for download on our website.

Shuttles/Parking: From 8:00am to 8:30am, one-way bus shuttles will depart from the Reiter Center and take runners to the race start. There will be an additional late bus at 8:40am for 5K participants only. Parking is available at Don Burnside Park in Three Lakes. Note: You can drive to, or be dropped off at, the start lines. However there will not be any shuttle services back to the start lines following the race.

Proceeds from the event will be used to keep our trail beautiful year-round, help fund our local athletic running programs in the Three Lakes School District, and continue to promote healthy and active living in the Northwoods.

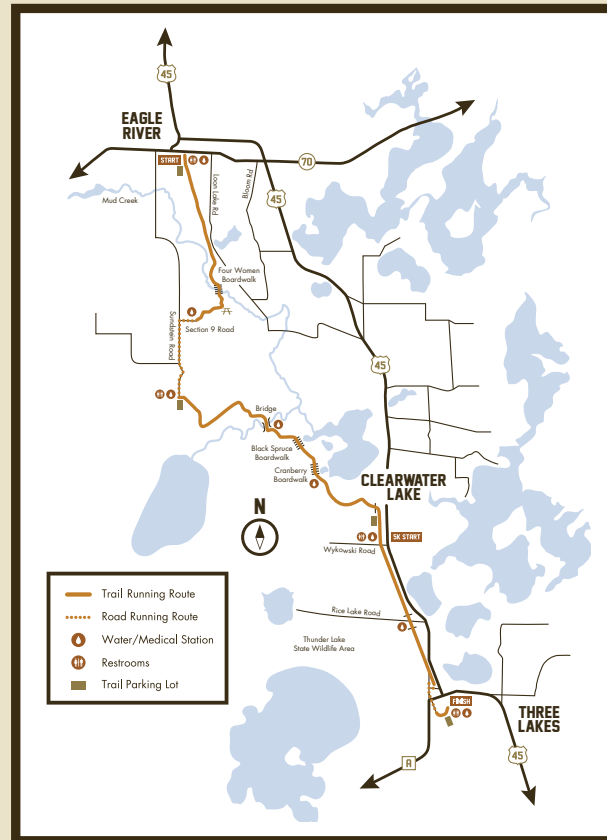
4:00-7:00pm - Late Registration & Packet Pick-Up at the Reiter Center in Three Lakes

 9:00am - Race Start (Post-Race food, drinks and massages available)
 10:00am - 5K awards
 11:30am - Half Marathon awards

Awards: Top overall Male and Female Finishers of the 5K and Half Marathon will receive awards. Age Group Awards are divided by 10-year increments. Register by October 1st to guarantee a race shirt. Half Marathoners will receive a custom finisher's medal.

Terms of Participation:

I know that running a trail/road race is a potentially hazardous activity. I should not enter and run unless I am medically able and properly trained. I also know that, although traffic monitors will be provided, there may be traffic on the roads. I also assume any and all other risks associated with running this event including but not limited to falls, contact with other participants, the effects of weather including high heat and/or humidity, or ice and snow, and the condition of the course. I know I may encounter wild and/or domesticated animals on the trail. I may also encounter non-participant individuals or groups of people biking, running, walking or otherwise using the trail because the trail is open to the general public at all times. I recognize that if I choose to wear a portable listening device during the race, that it may create a distraction which may increase my risk of injury. Runners or walkers with strollers must start in the rear. Knowing these facts, and in consideration of your acceptance of my entry fee, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, or anyone else who might claim on my behalf, covenant not to sue, and waive, release, and discharge the Three Eagle Trail Foundation, the race directors, and any organization associated with the race, and the local governments and police, assigns or volunteers, and any and all sponsors including their agents, employees, assigns or causes of acting on their behalf, from any and all claims or causes of action (known or unknown, foreseen, or unforeseen) for death, personal injury or property damage of any kind or nature including those arising out of their negligence in the course of my participation in this road race and all other events and activities associated with this race. I give my permission for medical team evaluation, treatment and transfer to an emergency facility if needed. I agree that Three Eagle Race officials have the right to remove me from the race and related activities if they are of the opinion that is in my best interest or the best interest of the event that I be removed. I further grant permission to the Three Eagle Race to use any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, recording, or any other record of this event for any purpose without limitation or compensation. I understand that fees are not refundable and race numbers and timing chips are not transferable. I agree to abide by the race instructions and understand that there is a three hour time limit after which the race course is not monitored by law enforcement associated with the event. All confirmed orders are final once payment is submitted. Registration fees are non-refundable. I have read the foregoing and certify my agreement by my signature on the registration form.
